## Prayer and Self-Denial

In Matthew 6, when Jesus was asked to teach His friends how to pray, He begins by acknowledging who God is and asking simply, "Your Kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in Heaven." That has been the overarching idea behind this year's Prayer and Self Denial – the hope of God's Kingdom being revealed and embraced.

That Kingdom represents the way things should be; the way things were always meant to be. No poverty, no injustice, no slavery and degradation of one person by another; the end of sin and death – the fullest and richest of right relationships in every sense between us, God and our world. Over the last 3 Sundays we have hoped to focus people's attention on this by using another key statement Jesus made about His purpose. In Luke 4 Jesus said: "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favour"
