Taize at St. Georges Gate Pa. Come and join for a quiet contemplative service based on the style and music of the Taize Community in France. 7pm Tonight (24 May).

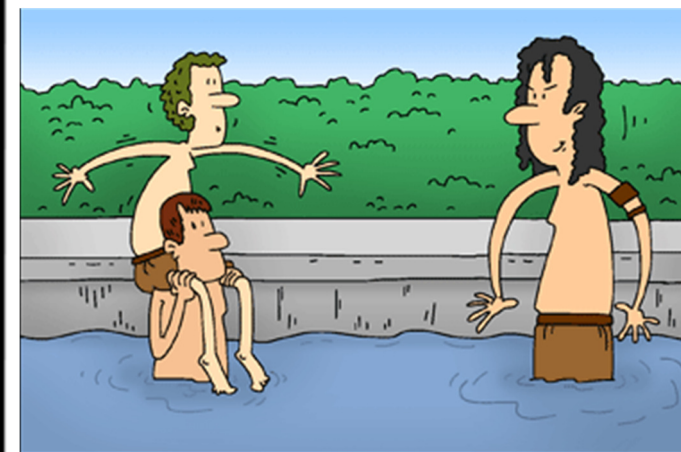
Towards belief DVD Series Resuming Sunday 7th June 7pm in the Chapel.
