Fresh Perspective (www.freshperspective.org.nz) is a subsidiary service of the Open Home Foundation developing a network of family mentoring services in partnerships with various Christian churches throughout New Zealand. This mentoring service aims to help individuals and families to recognise their strengths and abilities and to link them with support in their community.

This is not just for people working with Fresh Perspective, it is for anyone in a mentoring or life coach situation.
